

(Read this aloud daily—Why?)

(Ps.64:1, Ps.142:1 Rom. 10:17)

“Voice” in Hebrew- to sound aloud, bleat

I Will Never Rise Above My Confession

(Rom.10:10, 4:17, Matt. 12:34)

Therefore, today I choose life, not death, to be blessed not cursed. I confess with my mouth thy word is truth. (**John 17:17**) Your truth is a shield. (**Ps. 91:4**) You change not. (**Mal. 3:6**) You are the same yesterday, today and forever. (**Heb. 13:8**) There is no shadow of turning in you. (**James 1:17**) You have magnified **Your Word** above all Your name. (**Psalms 138:2**)

Behold the Lords hand is **not** shortened that it *cannot* save, *nor* is His ear heavy that it *cannot* hear, but **my** iniquities (willful known sin) have made a **separation** between me and my God and **my sins** have **hid His face** from me, so that He *will not* hear. (**Isa. 59:1-2**) I **acknowledge my sin** unto you, and **my iniquity** I have **not hid**. I said, I will **confess** my transgressions to the Lord, and *You forgave* the iniquity (known, willfulness) of my sin. (**Ps. 32:5**) He that covers his sins, shall **not** prosper, but whoso **‘confesses’** (acknowledges) and **‘forsakes’** (repents) **them shall have mercy.** (**Prov. 28:13**) **If I confess** my sin You are *faithful* and *just* to forgive my sin and to cleanse me from all unrighteousness. (**I Jn. 1:9**) For all the paths of the Lord are **mercy** and **truth** unto such as **‘keep’** His covenant and His testimonies. (**Ps. 25:10**) Who can come to Your Holy mountain? He who has clean hands and a pure heart. (**Ps.24:3-4**) Who has the right to the tree of life? They that do Your commandments. (**Rev.22:14**) I will **hear** therefore, and **observe** to **‘do it’** (His Word) that it may be well with me, and that I **may increase mightily**, as the Lord God has promised me, in the land that flows with milk and honey. I will **‘beware’** (watch) *less I forget the Lord*, which brought me forth out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage. I will diligently **keep** the commandments of the Lord my God, and **do** that which is **right** and **good** in the sight of the Lord...that I may go in and possess the good land. (**Deut. 6:3, 12, 17-18.**) I will **go through** each affliction, chastening, and test **to the provision**, being thankful in all things, giving glory to your name, **for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus!** (**1 Thes.5:18**)

You attend to the voice of my prayer. (**Ps. 66:19**) The secret things belong to you, but those things revealed belong to me and my children forever. (**Deut. 29:29**) I will attend unto Your words, I will submit my ear to your sayings. They **will not depart** from my eyes. I will keep them in the midst of my heart. For they are life to those who find them, and health (healing,remedy,calmness) to all my flesh. I will keep my heart with all diligence, for out of it are the well springs of life. (**Pro. 4: 20-23**)

Satan, with great boldness I say to you and your principalities I give you **no place** in my life today (**Eph. 4:27**) on **the authority of Jesus’ name** and the Word of God, I put you under my feet (**Luke 10:19**) For I **dwelling** in the secret place of the Most High, I **abide** under His shadow. He is my refuge and my habitation. I have **set my love** upon Him and He knows my name. In Him **do I trust** (**Ps.91**) I come against and bind every **spirit of fear** that seeks to control me (**2Tim. 1:7**), every **spirit of deception** that seeks to blind

me to the truth with a lie. (2 Cor. 4:4, Mt.18:18, Mt. 12:49) I submit to God, I resist you with the Word of God and Jesus' name, and now you must go. (Ja. 4:7) For Jesus and His blood through the power of the cross has given me all victory over you. (Lk. 10:19) No evil will befall me, no plague will come nigh my dwelling. A thousand may fall to my left, ten thousand to my right, but it **will not** come nigh unto me. (Ps. 91) **No weapon** formed against me shall prosper. (Is. 54:17) I call forth the angels of the Lord to go before me (family members) and behind me (us), to encamp round about me (us), to be placed in charge over me(us) to keep me (us) in all of my (our) ways. (Ps.34:7, Ps. 91:11) For the angels of the Lord hearken unto the voice of Your Word. (Psalms103:20) I will not be afraid of the terror by night, nor the arrow that flies by day, nor for the pestilence that walks in darkness (Ps. 91) I choose today to go **a little farther**, and not miss the moment when angels come. (Mt.26:39, Lk. 22:43) When asked to go one mile I will gladly go two. (Mt.5:41) To murmur not, (1 Cor. 10:10) for he who keeps his mouth keeps his life, but he who opens wide his lips shall have destruction (**ruin**). (Prov. 13:3) Set a guard, O Lord, over my mouth, keep watch over the door of my lips. (Ps. 141:3) So that I will set the proper course (Ja. 3:4) **for faith** not doubt and unbelief, **for healing** not sickness and disease, **for abundance**, not lack, **for victory** not defeat, **for deliverance** not bondage, **for courage** not fear, **for boldness** not timidness because You are able to do exceedingly abundantly above all I could ask or think **according** to the **power** that is in me (Eph. 3:20)

'In order to have what I have never had, I must do what I have never done.'

Therefore, I am putting you **first** in my life, I give you the **first of the first** of my finances (the tithe of my money), the **first of the first** of my day (the tithe of my day), the **first of the first** of my week (the Lord's day, the tithe of my week), and I give you the **first of the first** of my year (with prayer & fasting) and trust you to redeem the rest. (Ex. 23:19, Ex.22:29) Holy Spirit of God help me today to increase my faith, for out of the abundance of my heart my mouth speaks. (Mt. 12:34)

Lord, I ask You to liberate me from **all doubt**, from every kind of **skepticism** that would prevent me from experiencing the very best you have for me. I proclaim this as a year of the Lord's favor in my life (family's life). (Lk.4:18-19) I acknowledge that both my financial health and physical health are intertwined to my spiritual health. For You **wish above all things** that I would **prosper** and be **in health** even as my soul prospers. (3John: 2) I will not let You go until you bless me. (Gen. 32:26) I will **not cast away** my confidence (Heb. 10:35) which has a **great recompense** (compensation) of reward.

I will be **diligent** (haste, zeal, eagerness) not lazy, being followers of them through **faith** and **patience** (endurance) **inherited** (received) the promises. (Heb. 6:11-12) You Lord bless the righteous with favor; You surround him as a shield. (Ps. 5:12) Your eyes are searching to show Yourself strong in behalf of those whose heart is perfect toward You. (2 Chron. 16:9) We will shout for joy and be glad... we will say continually 'Let the Lord be magnified who takes pleasure in the prosperity of His servants'. (Ps.35:27)

You have given us all things through Your promises. (**2Peter 1:3-4**) I will hold fast to this confession, (**Heb. 10:23**) and not allow anyone to talk me out of my faith. You do not alter the thing that has gone out of Your lips, therefore I will not allow my lips to alter Your Word in any way (**Ps. 89:34**) I choose to be one of a different spirit. (**Num. 14**) If You said it, You will do it. If You spoke it, You will bring it to pass. (**Hab.2:2-3**) I acknowledge that I will never conquer or change what I refuse to confront, whether it be with myself or with others. (**Rom.8:37. Mt. 18:15, Mt. 5:23-24, Mt.21:12**) Let the righteous smite me in kindness and reprove me, it is oil upon the head, let not my head refuse it. (**Ps. 141:5**) A man who hardens his neck after much reproof, will suddenly be broken beyond remedy. (**Prov.29:1**) For it is written turn you at My reproof, behold I will pour My Spirit unto you, I will make known My Words to you. (**Prov.1:23**). Because I have set my love upon You, I have the assurance You will deliver me. (**Ps 91:14**)

Just as the farmer believes that the seed he has planted has begun to work before he sees it grow, I choose to have faith in the “imperishable seed” of Your Word as I plant it into my circumstances to believe that it is already doing its work without waiting to see (**Mk. 11:21-24, Mt. 21:18-22**) I believe Your Word, I speak forth Your Word, and I act on Your Word, for faith without works is dead. (**James 2:26**) **Now** faith is the substance (knowing) of things hoped for, the evidence (assurance) of things not seen. (**Heb. 11:1**) Without faith it is impossible to please You, and that which is not of faith is sin. (**Heb. 11:6, Rom. 14:23**) You Lord are the rewarder to them that diligently seek you. (**Heb. 11:6**) So I choose to walk in obedience to all Your Word so that You can feed me with the finest of wheat, to pour out honey from the rock, to subdue my enemies and my adversaries. (**Ps. 81:13-14, 16**)

Ps. 29 “Give unto the Lord, O you mighty, give unto the Lord glory and strength. Give unto the Lord the glory due unto His name; worship the Lord in **the beauty of holiness**. The voice of the Lord is upon the waters, the God of glory thunders, the Lord is upon many waters. The voice of the Lord is powerful; the voice of the Lord is filled with majesty. The voice of the Lord breaks the cedars, yes the Lord breaks in pieces the cedars of **Lebanon** (whosoever falls upon the rock shall be broken, but on whomsoever it falls shall be ground to powder”, **Lk 20: 18**), “The righteous will flourish (to break forth, to bloom, spread) like the palm tree, he will grow like a cedar in Lebanon. Those planted in the house of the Lord will flourish in the courts of our God. They will still bring forth fruit in old age; they will be full of sap and very green.” **Ps 92:12 – 14** “He makes Lebanon skip like a calf and **Mount Herman** like a young wild ox. The voice of the Lord divides the flames of fire (lightening - those things about to burn you). The voice of the Lord **shakes** the wilderness; the Lord **shakes** the **wilderness** of **Kadesh**. The voice of the Lord makes the deer to **calve** (brings about new birth) and strips bare the forest (exposes hidden things) and in His Temple does everyone speak His glory. The Lord sits upon the flood (He controls the heavens and that which is about to drown you), yes the Lord sits as king forever. The Lord will give strength unto His people; the Lord will bless His people with peace.”

Bless the Lord O my soul and all that is within me, bless His Holy name. Bless the Lord O my soul and forget not **all His benefits**. Who forgives **all** (1) my iniquities, who

heals **all** (2)my diseases, who (3) redeems my life from destruction, who (4)crowns me with loving kindness and (5)tender mercies, who (6)satisfies my mouth with good things, who(7) renews my strength and (8)my youth like the eagles. (**Ps103:1-5, Is.40:31**) In Jesus' Name **AMEN** (so be it)

Explanation of the latter part of Ps.29

Hebrew word meaning:

Lebanon – White

Mt. Herman – Consecrated Place

Kadesh – Sacred place, Sanctuary

Wilderness – Dry, barren place

Shakes -

Calves – Same word – to be in labor, to give birth, deep anguish, distress, pain

Everything that comes to the believer is either caused or allowed by God, therefore God Himself will cause or allow deep anguish, distress or pain, in order to bring about a birth of righteous, holy, obedient, uncompromised living in the dry, barren (unfruitful) areas of our life (sanctuary).

He will shake these things in our life that we have grown to trust in more than Him. He will shake areas of willful disobedience and compromise.

We will choose to willfully humble ourselves individually before the mighty hand of God in absolute obedience or He will do the humbling.
